

***Next~Quest 2000 Internet Dial-up Settings***  
This sheet is for users with Windows 2000 (4.0 & 5.0)

**Internet:**

1. Double click on the *My Computer* icon.
2. Double click on Network and *Dial-up Connection*  
Double click on *Make New Connection*.
3. Click on Next on the Network Connection Wizard
4. Select Dial Up to the Internet *Click Next*
5. Select I want to set up an Internet Connection Manually, or I want to connect through a local area Network (LAN) *Click Next*
6. Select I connect through a phone line and a modem *Click Next*
7. Type in the phone number that is local to your area (Next~Quest 2000 is not responsible for long distance charges you may incur while connected)

8. Uncheck use area code and Dialing rules *Click Next*
9. Type in username and password (Make sure to use lower case in your username and password the servers are case sensitive) *Click Next*
10. Type in Next~Quest 2000 *Click Next*
11. When you are asked do you want to setup an Internet Mail account now *Click NO*.
12. Uncheck to connect to the internet immediately, *Click Finish*.
13. Right click on Next~Quest 2000 and select Properties
14. Click on the Networking tab at the top
15. In the components checked are used by this connection box click on Internet Protocol (TCP/IP) once to highlight it and click on properties
16. Leave obtain an IP address automatically checked
17. Click on use the following DNS Server Address

Preferred DNS Server	12.47.168.2
Alternate DNS Server	12.127.16.69
18. Click OK
19. Click OK
20. Right click on Next~Quest 2000 and click on Create Shortcut
21. A screen will pop up that says (Windows cannot create a short cut here do you want the shortcut to be placed on the desktop instead) *Click Yes*
