

Windows NT Setup

Please note, the following text descriptions show how to make a connection to Next~Quest 2000.

1. Checking for installed components

Go to Start... Programs... Accessories... Dial-Up Networking
Select Next~Quest 2000 (if no Next~Quest 2000 icon, click New and advance to the next step)

2. Inputting information:

3. Configuring the Modem

Click on the More button.
Click on the Edit entry and modem properties menu option.
Click the Basic tab.
Set Entry name to Next~Quest 2000
Set Phone number to:
Next~Quest 2000 access numbers 367-4999
333-5148
536-2885

4. Set Dial using to your particular modem then click on the Configure button.

Set Initial speed (bps) to 38400 or 57600
Check all Hardware Features.
Click the OK button.

5. Select the Server tab.

Set Dial-up server type to PPP: Windows NT, Windows 95 Plus, Internet.
Check TCP/IP under Network protocols.
Check off Enable software compression.
Check off Enable PPP LCP extensions.
Click on the TCP/IP Settings button.

Mark Server assigned IP address.
Mark Specify name server addresses.
Set Primary DNS to 12.47.168.2
Check Use IP header compression.
Check Use default gateway on remote network.
Click on the OK button

6. Select None

7. Click the OK button.

8. Click on the Security tab.

Select Accept any authentication including clear text.
Click on the OK button.

You will now be able to dial into Next~Quest 2000 with your Windows NT computer.
